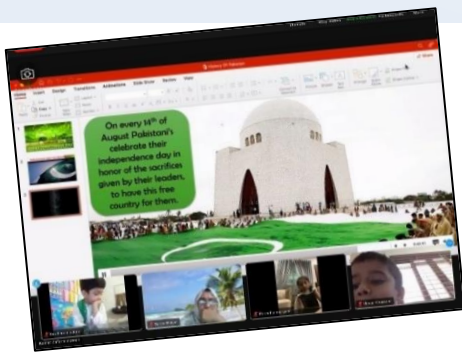


## Independence Day Celebration

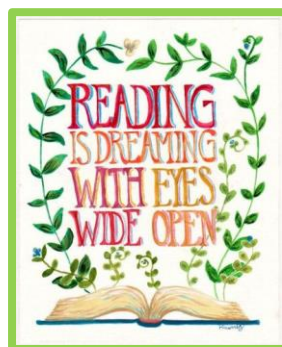

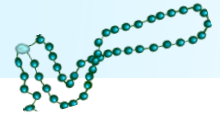

## Awareness Program

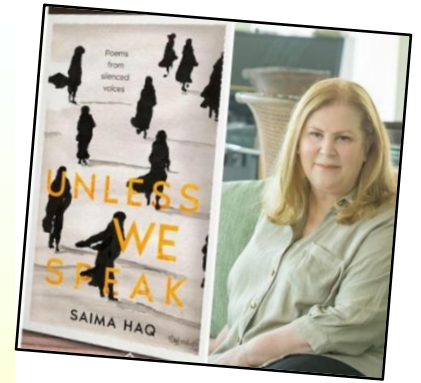
